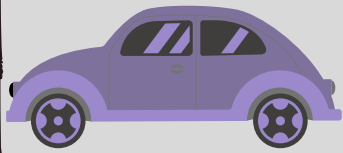

COVID-19 Protocol

The following guidelines have been implemented in our office to ensure a safe environment for our clients.

Prior to coming into the office, we will email each client our current COVID-19 policies and procedures.



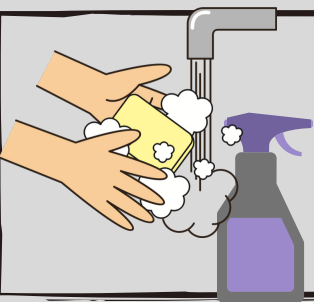
- We will not utilize the waiting room. We ask that you wait in the car or on the porch upon arrival and we will meet you on the front porch.
- Parents and caregivers are asked to please wait in your vehicle or on the porch for the duration of the therapy visit.
- All clients will exit utilizing our side door on the porch. Parents please meet the therapist at the side door at the completion of your child's session.



- Temperature checks, utilizing an infrared forehead thermometer, and a short health questionnaire for clients will be conducted prior to entering the office. If anyone in your family has been ill, we ask that you call and reschedule you or your child's therapy session.
- Our therapists will also be monitoring and documenting their own temperatures daily.



- Our therapists will be wearing scrubs and PPE, including a face mask, face shield, and gloves during therapy sessions. Therapists may also use a plexiglass divider with clients as appropriate.
- Employees will wash their hands before and after each client.
- Adult patients will be required to wear a face mask and PPE supplies provided by our therapists.



- The office continues to be professionally cleaned and disinfected utilizing CDC/OSHA recommended products.
- Disinfecting protocol will occur after each therapy session including toys, tables, door knobs, etc.
- Toys utilized during therapy sessions will be kept to a minimum. Fabric toys, sensory bins, playdough, etc. will not be utilized.



We will continue to offer and follow teletherapy guidelines as allowable per state mandate.
